<u>Clavis Orea Medoc</u> was launched on the 2019 vintage and put recently on market, we always wanted to have a Left Bank version of our Clavis Orea St Emilion, a new partnership of **Franck Jugelmann**, who started his career a cellar employee at chateau Landiras, Graves, and then Haut Brion, then assistant Cellar Master at **Mission Haut Brion**, and **finally winemaker at Chateau Fonplegade GCC St Emilion**, **Ch Candale GC**, **L'Enclos** in **Pomerol**.. This project in Medoc is a partnership with the Merlaut family own group Taillan owners of several Chateaux on Left bank and Sauternes, BC Canada..,

<u>The project is managed</u> with our own work book program by Franck Jugelmann from Vineyard to bottle, at the Ch Carcanieux Medoc CB, Carcanieux in local dialect-patois means "Caillasse" south of Queyrac, neighbour of Ch Layauga Dubosq that belong partially and vinified by Dubosq of Ch Haut Marbuzet, this location in the heart of Medoc represent among the best terroir, and with high typicity of Left Bank Medoc, fruit driven, juicy and their freshness make their wine very accessible,

The debut vintage for Franck Jugelmann in the <u>Left Bank</u> produced a meaty, earthy, spicy and smoky wine, with thyme, vanilla, red fruits and green leafy notes in the nose. Tasted on June 15, 2020 by <u>Yves Beck</u> Switzerland 50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 42% Merlot, 8% Petit Verdot The bouquet of Clavis Oréa Médoc reflects the freshness and fruity expression of Cabernet Sauvignon. Delicate notes of black currants and black pepper. On the palate, the wine has temperament, but also fullness. It is precise and has firm tannins that slowly reveal themselves.
