

CHÂTEAU ROMEFORT

VINTAGE 2018



Château Romefort is the wine from a single vineyard located on the plateau of Cussac-Fort-Medoc belonging to the Château Lamothe-Bergeron.

Tasting note : The nose of Château Romefort 2018 opens with aromas of black currant and raspberries together with toasted notes. The attack is clean, the mid-palate generous and the tannins intense but controlled. Medium to long finish.

Blending of the vintage : 70% Merlot, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon.
Yield of the vintage : 39 hl/ha.

Localisation : South of Cussac-Fort-Medoc village.

AOP : Haut-Medoc.

Terroir: Garonne gravel and black sand.

Area : 18 hectares.

Grape varieties : 70% Merlot, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon.

Average age of the plants : 15 years old.

Vine Growing: tillage, green manure, mixed Guyot pruning, debudding, leaf stripping, grass planting.

Environmental certification : HVE (High Environmental Value).

Vinification: in thermo-regulated stainless-steel vats, cold maceration (8°C), pumping over.

Ageing: Vat (2/3) and 2 wines barrels (1/3).

Jeb DUNNUCK - 90/100

The 2018 Château Romefort has lots of dark cherry and currant fruits as well as notes of tobacco, cured meats, and spice. Medium-bodied, full-bodied, round, and impressively textured, it's one heck of an impressive Haut-Médoc to drink over the coming decade.

JAMES SUCKLING – 90/100

Aromas of dark tea, walnuts and bark with some plums. Medium body, fine tannins and a fresh, delicate finish. Very drinkable now, but even better in a year or two.
