AOC Sauternes sweet wine



This 150 years old property was purchased in 1993 by the previous part owner of château Suduiraut, Philippe Mercadier, from Jacqueline Tuytens-Laville. Philippe's main vineyard interests are in Languedoc, but he couldn't get Sauternes from under his skin and when this little property came up for sale, he grabbed it. The estate is in the commune of Fargues, just east of Rieussec and to the north of château Fargues, on the gentle lower slope that stretches from the Langon Sauternes road to the woods by château de Malle.

Average age of the vine: 50 years.

Vineyard management: harvest with successive sorting (10 times) of the noble rot grapes.

Winemaking: traditional harvest in small steel vats, fermentation over 1 month.

Ageing: in French oak barrel for 12 months

Tasting note:

Pale yellow with green tints. Aromas of citrus fruits underline with floral notes. On the palate the wine is lively and elegant. The lemon flavor comes out with crystalized notes. Good persistence for the finale. To serve with a chicken liver paté, veal with mushroom risotto, blue cheese.

80% Semillon

20% Sauvignon Blanc
